# Medical Assisted Treatment Program – Sheriff's Office

Lt. Chip Udischas and Captain Dean Hettinger Sheriff's Office and Mrs. Robin Schonauer, Budget Director via teleconference attended the meeting to discuss the Medical Assisted Treatment Program. He presented the Commissioners with a presentation and explained the need for the Medical Assisted Treatment Program (MAT). This program is for the inmates with opioid addiction and it has multiple benefits. Funding is 100% reimbursable from the State of Ohio. The grant funding is through CBHC and the initial expense as well. They are willing to

wait until we are reimbursed to pay for this service. He is anticipating that they will have 4 to 5 people per month that will utilize this program. He stated that what they are asking is that the grant funding comes back to the Sheriff's Office so that they will be able to pay CBHC for this service. He then reviewed the benefits of the program. Mr. Udischas then asked to give a brief update on the jail. He first thanked the Commissioners for the additional help in the jail. He stated that they will possibly receive a recommendation from the State to have medical personnel in the jail to pass medications. This will cause an additional cost to the jail as well. He just wanted to make certain the Commissioners are aware that this will probably be coming. Lt. Udischas then stated with the MAT, if we can get inmates started and have several injections, then their success rate is much higher. Something like 60% or more higher. The Commissioners are in favor of instituting this program and asked them to proceed.
