#### OSU Annual Update

Mrs. Emily Marrison, Mrs. Jenny Strickler, Mr. David Marrison and Mrs. Alona Hoffman from OSU Extension attended the meeting via zoom and presented their Annual Update. Mrs. Marrison thanked the Commissioners for allowing them to zoom in today. Mrs. Marrison explained how OSU received their funding. She then reviewed the Family and Consumer Sciences for the county in 2020. She was able to adjust the way they did things last year to reach as many people as possible. She did online cooking classes and continues to focus on food safety, home food preservation, health and wellness and SNAP-Ed Nutrition education. Mrs. Jenny Strickler then gave her update on 4-H Youth Development in 2020. She reviewed the Afterschool Agriculture, Shooting Sports Education and 4-H Camp (virtual in 2020). She also reviewed the Junior Fair Activities, 4-H Junior Leadership, Assurance Quality Care for Animals, Spin Clubs and Project Evaluations. She continues to do statewide activities and professional development. She stated that they have lost some kids in the program due to the Corona Virus. She hopes to get them back this year once they are able to get back in the schools. Mrs. Hoffman then explained her duties with 4-H and Agriculture and Natural Resources. She explained her ability to get into the schools and how this has affected the number of participants. She hopes these numbers will increase once she can get back into the schools. Mr. Marrison then presented the Agriculture and Natural Resources Highlights. He reviewed his program from 2020. He stated that they were half way through their program when Covid hit. He is hoping that things will get back to normal this year. He was able to get the pesticide training, agronomy school and most of the farm breakfasts in prior to the pandemic. He was a able to do a Farm Financial Management Workshop, Farm Bill Training, Farm Succession Workshop, Hay Qualit-
