2nd Public Hearing - CARES Act Funding - New EMS Building

At 10:00 a.m. Mr. Dane Shryock opened the 2nd Public Hearing with Mr. John Cleek attending the meeting via teleconference. Mr. Cleek stated that this is a required public hearing for Cares Act funding and we will be applying for 2,577,000 of cares act funding and 1,0500,000 of local funding for a total project in the amount of \$3,627,000.00 he will submit the grant and we should hear back from the State of Ohio by June of 2021.
