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## Tammi Rogers-Recycling and Litter Prevention

Mrs. Tammi Rogers attended the meeting to give a quick update before she finalizes her budget for next year. She had general discussion with the Commissioners in regards to her concerns with her bare bones budget and being just shy of \$15,000.00 for her total budget. The amount that is shy also includes the sheriff's office and health department as well. Mrs. Rogers stated she is working closely with Mr. Zach Fanning at the Health Department as well as Mrs. Beth Walsh at the sheriff's office to help make up those budget shortfalls for next year. Mrs. Rogers finalized budget will be complete the end of next week and is due to CFLP on September 30<sup>th</sup>. On a positive note Mrs. Rogers stated that cardboard is bringing in more right now, however, that is not something you can count on long-term. In closing, it was discussed that all counties in the CFLP district are facing the same budget cuts and that many of the counties have eliminated the health department from their budget altogether.
