Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan

Mr. Robbie McMasters, EMA and Mr. Guentter, Jr., RFG Associates attended the meeting to discuss the Natural Hazardous Mitigations Plan with the Commissioners. Mr. Guentter is the owner of a consulting firm whom was procured by the County five years ago to update the Natural Hazardous Mitigations Plan. This plan will be submitted to the Ohio EMA and FEMA for approval. By the County completing the Mitigation plan it will help the County to receive Federal funds for matters addressed in the Mitigation plan and to receive Emergency FEMA funding if needed. A committee began meeting in November of 2018 to discuss the County's past Natural Hazards and they ranked them accordingly to importance. The members on the committee consist of the County Engineer, EMA staff, County Health Department, Coshocton Fire, City of Coshocton and the Joint Vocational School. The top Hazards in the County were wind storms, flooding, Severe Winter Storms, Class 1 DAM repair, Tornadoes. The Mohawk DAM is the top priority for the County as it is in need of major repair, if the DAM would fail it would affect every town from Coshocton to Marriott. The top hazards for Coshocton County were ranked as follows: Mohawk Dame as the top priority the plan suggest to Lobby state and federal officials to budget funding to make repairs to Mohawk Dam, as per Army Corp of Engineers plans, 2) The CCEMA command center power /communications needs backup so it has full power during outages, 3) Evaluate location for a shelter in the Western end of Coshocton, 4) Evaluate the severity of risk of critical facilities in flood prone areas, and implement mitigation actions accordingly, 5) Develop a comprehensive annual public outreach/education plan for all hazards. The Mitigation plan will be posted on the EMA website for citizens to review for the next 14 days. Mr. Shryock ask Mr. McMasters to set up a meeting with the U.S. Corp of Engineer regarding their plan regarding repairs to the Mohawk DAM. The Commissioners thanked Mr. Guentter for attending.

Public Hearing PY 21 CDBG Targets of Opportunity

A 10:03 a.m. Mr. Shryock opened the public hearing. Mrs. Jillian Flowers, CDC of Ohio and Sheriff James Crawford attended the public hearing for the PY 2021 CDBG Targets of Opportunity Grant Funds. Mrs. Flowers stated that Coshocton County is eligible to apply for \$3,150,000 for the construction of a new Justice Center. The Justice Center meets the national poverty guidelines by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services of being 51% low-moderate income. The local match will be \$25,164,883.00, the total estimated project is \$28,314,883. The proposed work for the grant is expected to be done between May 1, 2022 and June 1, 2024. CDC of Ohio will be preparing the grant application for Coshocton County.
