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Road Vacation-TR 1054, Clark Township

Mr. Conkle made a motion to discuss the road vacation of TR 1054 in Clark Township, seconded by Mr. Fischer-the vacation of one unimproved street, Township Road 1054, West of Township Road 1053, in John Mullet’s addition to Blissfield, Ohio, Clark Township as Recorded in Plat Book 1, page 216. Being all of the 30 feet wide, platted street known as TR 1054, west of the platted street now known as TR 1053, between Lot 3 and Lot 4 and terminating at the westerly boundary of the platted subdivision. The Clark township trustees voted unanimously to pass a resolution and petition requesting the Coshocton County Commissioners to vacate TR 1054. Mr. Shryock stated that after talking with Mr. Fred Wachtel, Coshocton County Engineer, he was able to provided additional information in regards to this Township Road. He stated that to his knowledge this road was never developed. Therefore, we must follow ORC. 5553.042, which states that the Commissioners shall vacate the road. Mr. Fischer stated that two(2) out of the three(3) land owners did not want the road vacated and the one(1) who did want the road vacated was advised by the prosecutor to move their fence out of the right away. Additionally, the one(1) neighbor who did not want the road vacated advised that this was due in fact to the issue of access to their barn from this road. A roll call vote followed.

Mr. Rusty Dreher gave the Commissioners an update in regards to the new 911 dispatch console at the Justice Center and its working condition currently.

Ohio TT-Update

Mrs. Megan Kvamme, Mr. Kyle Yoder, Mr. Matt Armstead and Mr. Justin Embrey gave an update on Ohio TT in Coshocton County, also in attendance were Mr. Rusty Dreher and Mrs. Robin Schonauer. All equipment for Millcreek is in Ohio TT’s possession and the balance of equipment for the rest of the towers will be in their possession by mid-February. Ohio TT is looking for10 beta customers for testing to start February 1st, these 10 testers will be selected randomly. A Request for RFI has been sent out for the remaining co-locations and future new build towers. Two(2) co-location partners and four(4) new tower partners have been identified. Millcreek tower should be up and ready by Mid-March, and all other sites should be ready by this summer. 1400 residents in the Millcreek area could be served with this tower, this map can be seen live on the website for residents to view. Mrs. Kvamme stated she wants to reaching out to business as well that they can serve with the help of Mrs. Tiffany Swigert, Port Authority Director. Mr. Rusty Dreher has had weekly communication with Mr. Kyle Yoder in regards to progress within the county with service.

Tracy Haines-Mobility Management-Update

Mrs. Tracy Haines updated the Commissioners about the CR 621 bike path and forms letters that she would like to send out to the community to help receive donations for this project. If for some reason the project would not be complete the donations would be returned.

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


Meetings Attended
