#### Senator Brenner Introduction Coshocton County

Senator Andrew Brenner attended the Commissioners meeting at 11:00 a.m. to introduce himself as the new Senator to Coshocton County, due to redistricting. Also, in attendance to meet the Senator was Sheriff Crawford, Mrs. Janette Donaker, Treasurer, Mr. Fred T. Wachtel, County Engineer, Mr. Josh Kempf, Assistant County Engineer, Ms. Chris Sycks, Auditor, Ms. Alex Nelson, Recycling and Litter Prevention Director and Ms. Abby Benjamin, City of Coshocton. Senator Brenner introduced both Mr. Aaron Wiggins and Mr. Charles Perry, both aides to his office. Senator Brenner stated that his office covers Delaware, Knox, Holmes and Coshocton County. He is excited to work with and in Coshocton County, he would like to receive feedback from our elected county officials as to what they see the needs in our area are or concerns they may like to see addressed locally. Mr. Wachtel addressed the Senator about infrastructure needs within the county, he stated that during the pandemic when many establishments were shut down his office seen a decrease in fuel tax revenue to fix or maintain roads and bridges within the county. Ms. Sycks stated that she would like the Senator to think about smaller communities when enacting or changing legislature that would affect the Auditors office, and that she encourages Senator Brenner to reach out to her with any questions he may have moving forward. Mr. Shryock touched on the foster care system and how that money spent can really Shryock affect our general fund budget, he also spoke about OhioTT and the broadband expansion in the county. Mr. Shryock referenced the 4% unemployment in our county, stating that this is not an accurate representation of the county as there are plenty of jobs available to those who want to work. In closing, Senator Brenner is hopeful to have quarterly meetings with the Commissioners as he would like to get to know the area and needs of the area to better be prepared moving forward in the future. Mr. Shryock thanked him for his visit and encouraged him to visit the CR 1A property, known as Skips Landing to see the benefits Capital Improvement dollars can have on our community.
