### Job and Family Services Updates-Mr. Jed McCoy

At 10:00 a.m. Mr. Jed McCoy, DJFS Director presented the Commissioners with an update in regards to the back lot that was recently purchased in March from Tim and Alisa Howell. Mr. McCoy would like to contact funding sources via grants, community impact monies or local businesses to make that newly acquired area a green space for family visitations. Currently DJFS utilizes the County Fairgrounds for family visitations, however this is not always ideal when it comes to restrooms and ADA accessibility. Mr. Shryock stated that he would be in favor of that space becoming green space for DJFS and encourage Mr. McCoy to reach out for estimates and designs for that area as well as potential funding sources. Mr. McCoy also briefly spoke about the 15 million dollars that the State has released to DJFS statewide to help retain and workers as well as attract new employees, he has a meeting scheduled later this week to learn more about the \$59,000.00 of the 15 million that Coshocton County will be receiving.

### Recess


Mr. Shryock moved the meeting to recess at 11:45 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
