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Mr. Randy Carmel-Killbuck Watershed Land Trust

Mr. Randy Carmel from Killbuck Watershed Land Trust attended the Commissioners meeting to discuss almost 18 acres in Clark Township within Coshocton County that the Killbuck Watershed Land Trust would like to obtain with a letter of Support from the Coshocton County Commissioners. Mr. Carmel is the Board President of this foundation and would like the support of the Commissioners to help obtain Clean Ohio Funding to purchase those almost 18 acres in Coshocton. This group has acquired land in the last two funding rounds of Clean Ohio Grant. Killbuck Watershed Land Trust would like to conserve the wetlands acreage for a variety of reasons including for protecting open green space near Killbuck Village and the Crane Swamp Preserve, allowing rural regulation of water in the Killbuck Creek which aids in maintaining water quality, flood protection of the riparian corridor, to maintain wildlife habitat and for scenic values. Mr. Shryock stated that the Commissioners' would be in favor of this acquisition and are willing to sign a letter of support for this grant. The Commissioners thanked Mr. Carmel for his presentation.

Executive Session-CCCTA



Meetings attended



Mr. Shryock adjourned the meeting at 12:00 p.m.




