Mr. Cody Pettie, Ohio Treasurer of State

At 9:30 a.m. Mr. Cody Pettie and Mr. Dalton Throckmorton with the Ohio Treasurer of State presented the Commissioners a brief update on programs within their office. Once such program that Mr. Pettie talked about was ag-LINK, this program offers farmers lower interest rates on ag loans and business loans. This program runs year-round in the State of Ohio and is very vital to the ag community. Mr. Shryock asked if any local farmers have used the program, but that answer was not known but will be looked into. Mr. Pettie stated that over 2 million dollars were saved by farmers last year who utilized this program in the State of Ohio. Another program available through their department if the STABLE Account, this program makes it easier for employees with disabilities to save, invest, and achieve greater independence. Eligibility for the STABLE Account are individuals who develop disabilities before the age of 26. Lastly, Mr. Pettie spoke about the Family Forward program that helps families receive lower interest rates for private adoptions. Mr. Shryock thanked both gentlemen for their time and information.
