## Phone Call with Mr. Jeffery Harris from Graydon

At 9:30 a.m. Mr. Jeffery Harris, Graydon had a phone conversation with Mr. Shryock, Mr. Conkle, Mr. Rusty Dreher, Mrs. Mary Beck and Mrs. Robin Schonauer to discuss the Ohio TT Coshocton project. Mr. Shryock started the phone call thanking Mr. Harris for his time and introduced everyone in the room. Mr. Harris stated the reason for the phone call was to discuss Ohio TT Coshocton broadband related project and the ARPA dollars that are allocated for the project. Originally, the attorney working for Ohio TT Coshocton sent a new contract that Mr. Harris was not in favor of the Commissioners signing. However, after conversations between Mr. Harris and Ohio TT Coshocton's attorney, it was better explained to Mr. Harris the two new entities within Ohio TT. Ohio TT, Coshocton will be the only group working under that name to carry on the broadband project within Coshocton County. Mr. Harris additionally stated he was not in favor of the contract waiving the rights of the Commissioners in certain areas and he has since sent a copy of the revised contract for the Commissioners to sign on the next agenda. It was added that Mrs. Megan Kvamme is no longer the owner of Ohio TT, but she is still part of the Ohio TT, Coshocton broadband project. Lastly, Mr. Harris does not see any issues with the ARPA funds related to this project, as Ohio TT, Coshocton should still be supplying the Commissioners with the needed reports that will be reported back the federal government. Mr. Dreher stated that Ohio TT, Coshocton has built a new system internally to better track the number of customers they are servicing. Mr. Shryock thanked Mr. Harris for his time and said he feel more confident now moving forward.

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#### Public Hearing-Permissive Tax

At 10:00 a.m. Mr. Shryock opened up the Public Hearing for the Permissive License Tax with the following people in attendance: Commissioner Shryock, Commissioner Conkle, Mr. Frederick T. Wachtel, County Engineer, Mr. Joshua Kempf, Deputy Engineer, Mrs. Mary Beck, Mr. Rusty Dreher and Mr. Leonard Hayhurst, Tribune. No one from the public was present. Mr. Wachtel did state the Muskingum County is currently working on a Permissive Tax as well. Mr. Shryock wanted it noted that no one from the public attended either Public Hearings and that both Public Hearings were advertised twice in the Coshocton County Beacon. The two Permissive Taxes will be effective January 1, 2024.
