Public Hearing-TR 1500, Adams Township

At 9:00 a.m. there was a public hearing for the road vacation of Township Road 1500, Adams Township with the following people present: Mr. Fred Wachtel, County Engineer, Mr. Brian Lane and Ms. Carla Lane. Mr. Shryock began the meeting with introductions of all in the room and then asked for public comment. Mr. Lane began by asking what the decision that will be made is based on and then asked if he was able to bring up his own petition as a land owner. Mr. Shryock stated that once a decision is made anyone can file an appeal within 60 days to the common pleas court. Mr. Wachtel stated that the road vacation is being done due to the Federal Highway Department who has deemed the bridge on TR 1500 unsafe. Mr. Wachtel stated if the vacation is not approved the bridge will be taken out, if the vacation is approved the bridge will be replaced with a culvert for the landowners on TR 1500 to use. Mr. and Mrs. Lane do not want the bridge closed, as the earlier road vacation further up TR 1500 was not an easy vacation as the promised easement was never written up and done correctly. Additionally, Mr. Lane stated if the road vacation was approved it would decrease his property value tremendously, and they are in fear of being landlocked by this decision. Mr. Wachtel stated that they would not be landlocked. Mr. Wachtel recommends to vacate the road as the road/bridge serves no public purpose out of the 36000 residents in the county. Mr. Lane inquired about the money the township should have received over the years for this road and bridge. The County Engineers office is only responsible for the bridge, not the road that the township is responsible to maintain. Mr. Shryock stated he will take all comments under advisement when the final decision is made. Once a decision is made, we will send out letters to all who this will affect. Lastly, if the road is vacated the bridge/culvert will remain and if the road is not vacated the bridge will be taken out. Mr. Wachtel said Mr. Mullet has agreed if the road is vacated that the bridge/culvert will be fixed up somewhat to allow those who need to use it access to keep it in service as a private ownership not public. Mr. Lane is not in favor of this as he is afraid Mr. Mullet would put up a gate. Mr. Shryock would like to read the language on easements before a decision is made. Mr. Conkle stated he sees both sides of this issue. A determination will be made at a later date.

Report of Meetings Attended

Mr. Shryock attending a meeting on Wednesday, September 20, 2023 with the local Foundation Boards in regards to CR 1A funding, additionally on Friday, September 22, 2023 Mr. Shryock meet with Jillian Flowers, CDC of Ohio about additional design monies for the Appalachian Grant Program.

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


