# 2023 Year -Dog Wardens Report

The Commissioners received the Dog Wardens Report for the 2023 year with 279 dogs picked up by the warden, 53 dogs brought in as strays, 111 dogs euthanized, 425 dog license sold, 382 dogs sold, 158 dogs redeemed, 312 dogs surrendered per owner, 481 citations issued and 1825 calls handled for a total of \$19,800 in fees collected for the year. In 2023 333 reports were filed with 125 of those reports in the city and 208 in the county; 9,339 standard dog licenses sold, 44 3-year licenses sold, 9 permanent licenses sold and 98 kennel licenses were sold. Lastly, the total number of miles driven in 2023 by the dog wardens was 34, 113.

All three (3) Commissioners attended the Regional Planning meeting on Monday evening, January 22<sup>nd</sup>. Mr. Shryock had discussion with Mr. Ryan Medley, Soil & Water Conservation Director about additional office space for the state representative for Soil & Water on Tuesday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>.
