Sheriff Crawford, Deputy Union CBA Discussion

Sheriff Crawford and Lieutenant Mike White meet with the Commissioners to discuss the Agreement between the Coshocton County Sheriff and Fraternal Order of Police Ohio Labor Council Inc. for Deputy Sheriffs from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2026. This collective bargaining agreement will include an average of 4.24% wage increase over 3-years. Additionally, fringe benefits remain the same, as well as vacation rate, sick leave payout, compensation time and clothing allowances. An incentive was added to the agreement to promote deputies to become involved in special operations such as SRT and K9 with a stipend of \$300.00 given to outfit the needs of those individuals to become involved with those programs. With the wage increase deputies will top out at \$30.51 in three-year, Coshocton County is working hard to stay competitive with their neighboring counties, within budget parameters. Mr. Shryock asked if the 2024 wage increase was already figured in this year's budget to which Sheriff Crawford confirmed it was already shown in the 2024 budget.

Mr. Fischer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Conkle to sign the agreement between the Coshocton County Sheriffs and Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. Deputy Sheriffs effective January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2026 as presented by Sheriff Crawford.
