Mr. Fischer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Conkle to sign Resolution 2024-040, a resolution authorizing Ohio Means Jobs Coshocton County Employment Expo Funding Expenditures not to exceed \$300.00 during the employment expo event that will be held on Thursday, September 12, 2024.

Resolution 2024-041, Jed McCoy-Authorizing-Inter-County Adjustment

Mr. Conkle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Fischer to sign Resolution 2023-041, a resolution assigning authority to Jed McCoy, Coshocton County Department of Job and Family Services Director to act as the Coshocton Board of County Commissioners designee for approving inter-county adjustments of allocated funds.

Amended Resolution 2024-036, to add in needed wording

Mr. Fischer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Conkle to sign Amended Resolution 2024-036, a resolution declaring it necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation, for the OSU Extension at a rate not exceeding 0.40 mills for each one (\$1) dollar of taxable value, which amounts to \$12 for each \$100,000 of the county auditors appraised value.


Meetings Attended
