CAUV Program Discussion, Mr. Grant Daugherty, County Auditor

At 10:30 a.m. Mr. Grant Daugherty, County Auditor attended the Commissioners meeting with Mr. Travis Gregorich to discuss CAUV Computer Programs, also in attendance was Mr. Frederick T. Wachtel, County Engineer, Mr. Bob Bigrigg, Commissioner-Elect and Mrs. Robin Schonauer, Budget Director. Mr. Daugherty turned the meeting over to Mr. Gregorich to discuss the counites needs when it comes to a CAUV program. Mr. Gregorich started by saying that the county would benefit greatly from a CAUV program, currently what is being used is a spreadsheet that was built by Jessica Goodsell, who used to work in the GIS office, Mr. Jarrod Tipton from the Auditors office is able work with it now, however this is just a spreadsheet that is saved on one computer. There is a risk taken by using a method such as this, as Mr. Daugherty said he is worried about a computer crash and being left without anything to use. Mr. Gregorich currently works with 21 counties in Ohio, man hours are used internally and externally to build a system that is suited for each county. The system is able to accurately calculate soil rates for the CAUV rates. Having a program in place would be beneficial for rate increases as well, the system would be defendable as well. Mr. Shryock asked if a system like this would reduce man house in the office. Mr. Daugherty most likely in the future that could be the case. Once the system is up and built for the county, it will only need to be maintained. Mr. Shryock asked how long the system would take to build, to which Mr. Gregorich stated he would highly suggest to mandate a 1-1-2025 use in the contract. Mr. Shryock also asked about the ability of building a system that is needed in house, to which Mr. Wachtel stated he didn't think IT has the interest to do so. Mr. Gregorich also stated that a skill set will need to be leveraged and maintained for this program, preferably out of the Auditors office. Mr. Schonauer asked if quotes were had yet, to which she was told, no. Mr. Gregorich said there are two ways to build a system and he suggested getting quotes on both builds. Mrs. Schonauer said she would need to see a quote before moving forward with help in funding this program. Mr. Shryock stated that CAUV rates are complex as they are now anyways and the dependability to him is significant. Mr. Gregorich will work with both Mr. Daugherty and Mr. Wachtel moving forward to get quotes for Mrs. Schonauer. Mr. Shryock believes anything this office can do to move the county forward to make the county transparent moving forward is beneficial.
