## CEBCO, 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Reports

At 10:00 a.m. Ms. Cindi Herring from County Employee Benefits Consortium of Ohio (CEBCO) attended the Commissioners meeting to discuss the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter CEBCO reports. Currently, Coshocton County has an overall loss ratio of 86.8%, with two (2) claimants exceeding the \$125,000 pooling point. Medical claims increased by 44% from the previous period, with RX claims increasing by 91.36%. Ms. Herring reported that during October 2023 through September 2024 Coshocton County had 210 ER visits, with 109 of those being potentially avoidable. 89.7% of prescriptions were filled with generics and had a paid amount of \$215,269.00. Currently the top three (3) drug categories are Anti-Diabetics, Miscellaneous Therapeutic Classes and Antineoplastics and Adjunctive Therapies. Mr. Shryock thanked Ms. Herring for the presentation of information.

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West Lafayette Kirk Drain Discussion, Mr. Frederick T. Wachtel, County Engineer



Commissioner Bigrigg has volunteered to be a liason from the Commissioner's office to work with Mayor Tubbs on the grant application, additionally, Mr. Wachtel stated his office would assist in providing necessary documents for the application
