Road Petition Viewing, Alleys in Spring Mountain -Monroe Township

At 10: 30 a.m. the Commissioners had a public viewing of the petition of the Monroe Township Trustees for the vacation of all the alleys not already vacated in the Unincorporated Community now known as Spring Mountain, as created on the Plat of the Town of Van Buren, P.B. (transcribed), Page 185, and the Plat of Addition to Van Buren, P.B. (transcribed), Page 186, in Monroe Township.
