Cindy Herring-CEBCO

At 10:00 a.m. Mrs. Cindi Herring, CEBCO representative attended the Commissioners meeting to present the first quarter CEBCO report for Coshocton County. Currently, Coshocton County has an overall loss ratio of 84.8%, medical claims have decreased 5.9% from the previous period, with Rx claims increasing 28.2 % from the same time period. CEBCO captured 112 potentially avoidable ER visits with a potential savings of \$129,636. Anthem Prescription were filled by generics 89.6% of the time with a paid amount of \$291,925. The top three (3) drug categories are: antidiabetics, misc. therapeutic classes (Cancers), and ADHD/Anti-Narcolepsy-Obesity/Anorexiants.
