## Ribbon Cutting-Coshocton County Career Center

### Public Hearing-Franklin Township/JEDD

At 11:30 a.m., Commissioner Dane Shryock opened the Public Hearing for the Franklin Township/JEDD with the following people present: Commissioner Dane Shryock, Commissioner Robert Bigrigg, Commissioner Gary Fischer, Mrs. Mary Beck, County Administrator; Mrs. Brooke Alverson, Clerk; Mr. Max Crown, City of Coshocton Service Director; Ms. Sherry Kirkpatrick, City of Coshocton Auditor; Mr. Andrew Tumblin, Franklin Township Trustee; Mr. Mark Mills, Coshocton City Mayor; Mrs. Tiffany Swigert, Port Authority Director; Mr. Dennis Balo, Franklin Township Trustee; and Mr. Joshua Kempf, Coshocton County Engineer.

Mr. Shryock began by stating that the role of the Coshocton County Commissioners is to serve as the body for the public hearing, as they have no further role in the JEDD or its negotiations. He then turned the hearing over to Mrs. Swigert.

Mrs. Swigert stated that this is an expansion of the existing JEDD boundaries, consisting of three owner parcels that are on file. All information for this JEDD will remain the same as is currently in place; this is simply an expansion of the boundaries. The next step in the process, once all landowners have signed this contract, is to attend both the Franklin Township meeting and the City Council meeting to have the necessary documents approved by those entities so the JEDD expansion can take effect.

Mr. Shryock opened the meeting for public input. Seeing no one present from the public, there was no input. Mr. Shryock then closed the public hearing at 11:55 a.m.
