Commissioner Bigrigg had a Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) meeting on Tuesday morning, March 3rd, he also had a Kno-Ho-Co executive committee meeting via zoom later on that same evening. Lastly, Commissioner Bigrigg went to view the 483C bridge in Conesville as well as CR 273 to see the damages.

Commissioner Shryock attended the LEPC meeting on Tuesday, March 3rd, additionally he also discussed the 483C bridge in Conesville as well as CR 273 with County Engineer Joshua Kempf and drove out to both sites as well to see the damages.

Mary Beck, County Administrator Updates

Mrs. Mary Beck reported that she spoke with Tim Biggam on Tuesday afternoon regarding a potential project submission; however, there was insufficient time to proceed, as the application deadline was Friday. She noted that the proposed four-lane project is not eligible because the County is not included on the required federal list. County roads are also ineligible, as they were not included on the federal listing. Mary further explained that there may be an opportunity for the Skips Landing area to be properly mapped in light of new utility lines being installed. To accomplish this, the County would need to contact 811 and enroll in their system, which requires payment of an annual fee. Mary stated that she believes this step is necessary to ensure the County's infrastructure is accurately identified and protected. She also reported that the Derby Committee meeting is scheduled for today at 2:00 p.m.

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
