All three Commissioners attended a meeting at the library with the Mayor on Wednesday afternoon.

The Commissioners attended the Our Town Coshocton reception on Thursday, March 12th. The Commissioners discussed potentially reviewing funding for Our Town Coshocton in June if finances allow. The County currently provides \$5,000 in support. Commissioner Robert Bigrigg noted that the organization provides a return on that investment by benefiting both local businesses and residents. Commissioner Dane Shryock added that events organized by Our Town Coshocton help attract visitors to the area, which contributes to local spending and sales tax revenue.

Mary Beck, County Administrator Updates

County Administrator Mary Beck reported that she attended the RV Mentor meeting on Thursday, March 12th. She also met with representatives from the City of Coshocton and Granger regarding the power line that will run to the well field and discussed how best to address the situation at Skip's Landing.

In regards to a flag pole at the roundabout, one suggestion discussed was placing poles in the center of the roundabout. Mr. Don Wells, Albert Excavating will speak with McWane regarding the potential installation of three to four poles, including those that may be required for federal purposes. Mrs. Beck will also check with AEP due to the power lines being located in close proximity to the flag poles. Plans for a 60-foot flagpole in that area were also mentioned.

Mrs. Beck also reported that on Friday along County Road 1A, a fence was blown into the roadway and a power line was knocked down due to the high winds.


She provided an additional update regarding the pending lawsuit.


