Professional Service Agreement between Allwell and Sheriff's Office


During discussions, Commissioner Bigrigg shared information about PBS's *Empowered America* series in connection with the America250 initiative. Participation would require a joint marketing investment between the County and the City of approximately \$30,000 to promote the area as a "great place to live, work, and play," with about five hours of content across three episodes. Commissioner Shryock noted that while the opportunity could be valuable if funding were readily available, current budget constraints make it difficult to justify at this time. It was suggested that, if reconsidered, the effort should be approached as a collaborative initiative representing the county as a whole, with further discussion recommended with the City of Coshocton and the Port Authority.
