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Bid Opening, 2026 OPWC Resurfacing-Coshocton County Engineer

At 10:01 a.m. the 2026 OPWC Resurfacing Bid Opening took place with the following people present: Commissioner Bigrigg, Commissioner Shryock, Commissioner Fischer, Brooke Alverson, Clerk, Mary Beck, County Administrator, Josh D. Kempf, County Engineer, Andrew Small, The Shelly Company, Andrew Schlabach, Melway Paving and Terry Triner, Melway Paving. Mr. Joshua D. Kempf, County Engineer gave an engineer estimate of \$2,654,506.50. The bids were read aloud by Commissioner Bigrigg: The Shelly Company, Thornville, Ohio with a bid of \$2,644,611.55 and Melway Paving Co. In. Holmesville, Ohio with a bid of \$2,372,700.15.

Mary Beck, County Administrator/Project Manager-Updates

The County Administrator, Mary Beck reported that the signage for Skip's Landing has been ordered. Discussions were held with Milligan's regarding the creation of a bronze plaque recognizing local contractors, as well as an additional plaque listing the County Commissioners, administration, and other contributors.

It was also reported that both additional lights planned for Skip's Landing will be installed at the archway entrance. The representative from the Blue Star Mothers organization indicated that their current request is to install a light at the entrance to the Veterans Memorial, with banners attached to the light poles. Funding from the remaining one-time strategic allocation has been designated for the courthouse project; therefore, the County Commissioners will entertain covering the cost of the lighting requested by the Blue Star Mothers at the Veterans Memorial.
