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Mary Beck, County Administrator/Project Manager-Updates

County Administrator/Project Manager Mary Beck provided several updates on current projects and community activities. She shared that she was scheduled to be on the radio at 10:00 a.m. to discuss Skip's Landing and noted that the ribbon-cutting ceremony for the weekend celebration is also planned. Mary reported that the Farmers Market was well attended this past weekend, and the new playground continues to see a high level of activity and community use.

She also advised that installation of the flagpoles is scheduled for tomorrow. At Skip's Landing, low water levels have created issues at the boat ramp, and staff will work to improve conditions by adding gravel and riprap to help maintain access. Given the popularity of the playground, Mary recommended adding a water bottle filling station in the area. She noted that an existing water hookup is located to the right of the playground, between Don Wells Park and the playground, making it a suitable location for the station.

If funding remains available, Mary suggested constructing a restroom near the playground at Skip's Landing. She indicated that this location would better serve families and visitors than placing a restroom across the road near Skelly Park. Finally, she reported that installation of the bridge lighting is expected to be completed this week.
