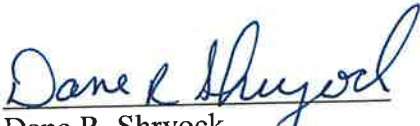
Mary Beck Updates

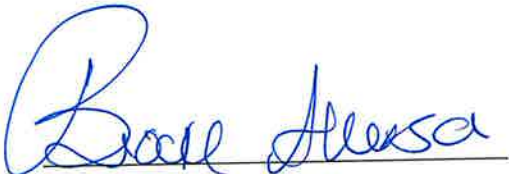
