Mr. Schonauer also expressed a desire to have a mental health service professional available to assist youth and families with their needs and to provide support from an independently licensed professional.

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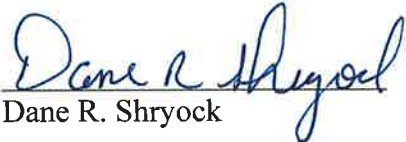
Meetings Attended

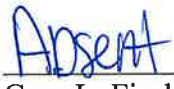

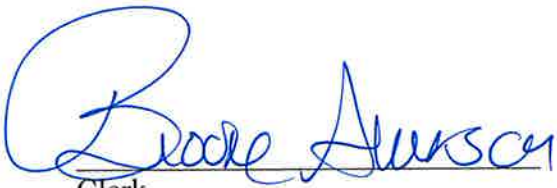
